He serves on the Legislative Committee of ACICA, the International Committee of the NSW Bar Association and on the Expert Advisory Committee on Working Group III (ISDS reform) for the UNCITRAL National Coordination Committee for Australia.

Boxun has extensive experience in high value ICC, HKIAC, ACICA and ICSID arbitrations.
